About Us

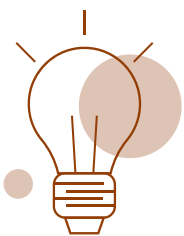
Gakami Mustard Seed Foundation

Guided by strong ethical values and community-centered approaches, the foundation focuses on practical, sustainable interventions that create measurable social and environmental impact across Kenya.

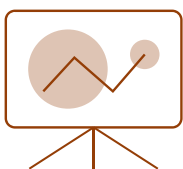

Key Programs and Projects

Empowering Loitokitok Project – Kajiado County



Tree Planting Initiative

- 12,500 trees planted in Olkiloriti, including:
- 3,500 fruit trees (oranges, mangoes, lemons)
- 9,000 assorted indigenous and exotic trees

Ongoing efforts to improve seedling survival through sustainable water solutions.

Rehabilitating Olkiloriti Primary School:



A Modern Office Block Under Construction by the Kajiado South MP A comprehensive community development initiative integrating environmental conservation, education, and infrastructure improvement.

- Ministry of Irrigation committed to sinking a borehole.
- Kajiado South Member of Parliament supported by building a modern office block.
- Local MCA donated two classes, and the school planted additional trees.
- Future plans involve renovating the school, re-tiling, painting, and providing new desks.

Empowering Kangema Project: Murang'a County



Since 2020, the Empowering Kangema Project has successfully planted over 100,000 trees, boasting an impressive 85% survival rate. This achievement reflects the dedication of local communities, volunteers, and environmental advocates working together to restore and protect Kangema's natural ecosystem.

- Planted over 100,000 trees since 2020, with 85% survival rate.
- Provided firewood to elderly individuals (aged 70 years and above) at Rwathia.
- Planted 5,000 Meru Oak seedlings, 400 bamboo trees, 500 Pondo, and assorted trees on October 17, 2023.

Namanga Health and Sports Development Project



The Mustard Seed Foundation is currently in discussions with well-wishers, local leaders, and development partners to bring this vision to life. The community health facility will provide essential medical services, ensuring that residents no longer have to travel long distances for treatment.

Community Tree Nurseries Initiative



A sustainable approach to reforestation through partnerships with community nurseries in Murang'a and Kajiado counties. Key Benefits – Reliable supply of quality seedlings – Income generation for local communities – Climate-adapted tree species cultivation – Collaboration with institutions including the Kenya Forest Service

Greening Police Stations Project



As the world grapples with climate change, Kenya has taken a bold step by launching the 15 Billion Tree Planting Initiative, spearheaded by H.E. President William Ruto, to be achieved by 2032. This ambitious initiative aims to reduce greenhouse emissions, reverse deforestation, and restore 5.1 million hectares of degraded land. In support of this national effort, the Gakami Mustard Seed Foundation is actively working with the Ministry of Interior to implement the Greening Police Stations Project, a nationwide tree-planting campaign aimed at transforming police stations into eco-friendly spaces.
